- 1. Apologies: C Pettingell, R and Y Arntsen

- 3. **Minutes of the Last Meeting:** These were not read out as they had been circulated to all present.
- 4. **Finances:** Gill read out the current financial position and confirmed the current bank balance. It was noted present funds are insufficient to cover liabilities for the next year. A fund raising appeal will be decided at the next meeting.
- 5. **Planning Application and Notices:** The Clerk went through the local planning applications and their present status.
- 6. **Allerton Waste Recovery Plant:** It was noted that this development was granted and work had commenced on road improvements. The Clerk will contact Amey Cespa for a schedule of road disruption.
