MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 8TH MARCH 2014 AT THE MASONS ARMS

- 1. Apologies: C Parkin, J Halstead, D Robinson, Y Arntsen
- 2. **Minutes of the Last Meeting:** These were not read out as they had been circulated to all present.
- 3. **Finances:** Gill read out the current financial position and confirmed the current bank balance. It was noted current funds should cover liabilities for the next year.
- 4. **Planning Application and Notices:** The Clerk went through the local planning applications and their present status. The Clerk informed the meeting of local sites put forward by HBC for possible development. The nearest being at Hay-A-Park. A further discussion took place regarding the Flaxby developments (both Hotel and Park and Ride).
- 5. **Allerton Waste Recovery Plant:** It was noted that this development was still pending a decision by NYCC. It is anticipated that this would be made towards the end of the year.
- **6.** Road Surface and Potholes: It was noted that Highways had completed their annual road survey and filled in some potholes.
- 7. **Crime Figures:** These were produced for 2013 showing 13 crimes in the Parish with 4 detected.
- 8. **Tour De France:** The Clerk was tasked with finding out more information regarding road closures etc.

It was noted that it is anticipated that substantial numbers of spectators will arrive for viewing and this presented both a financial opportunity for both village funds and local businesses.

A further meeting will be arranged to finalise plans.

- 11. **Faster Broadband**: The Clerk had been in touch with a broadband provider who runs community schemes. The Company is interested in providing a service to Allerton and Hopperton. Members and the Castle all confirmed their interest (The Castle will be the largest single user). A review of feasibility and costing will be undertaken to establish if the scheme is viable.
- 12. **Any Other Business**: It was again noted that dog fouling was taking place on the road verges in Hopperton. Could all owners please clear up any dog mess.
