## MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEETING HELD ON SATURDAY $24^{\text{TH}}$ SEPTEMBER 2016 AT THE MASONS ARMS

- 1. Apologies: A and C Parkin, M Madden
- 2. Minutes of the Last Meeting: The Clerk went through the last Minutes and updated those present with any actions taken. Member's agreed to the Clerk requesting that the area at King Street/Hopperton Street be added to North Yorkshire Council's register of common land. The Clerk will make the application.
- 3. Water Table, Flooding and Overflowing Septic Tanks: Members raised the issue of the apparent over flowing septic tank by the Homestead and requested that the Homestead have the issue looked at and for the Clerk to contact Environmental Health. The Clerk has now done this. A general discussion took place about drainage along Hopperton Street and the Clerk was requested to contact Highways/Environment Agency to discuss what could be done.
- 4. Flood Alleviation Schemes: These were discussed in light of 3 above.
- 5. Flaxby Housing Development: It was generally agreed that this would be a fait accompli. Members expressed their concern about increased traffic from both this coupled with the Allerton Waste Plant traffic. It was requested the Clerk submit a letter to the relevant planning department raising the highways and traffic concerns.
- 6. Hedge at Junction of New Road and Hopperton Street on York side: A request was made for the Clerk to request if the Land Owner (The Estate) would consider altering the hedge by either substantially lowering it or replacing it with open fencing and thereby increasing visibility on the corner entering Hopperton Street.

## 7. Any Other Business:

- i. It was noted that the fibre cabinet was now up and running and that for most of Hopperton the internet speed had increased. However issues still existed at the lower end of Hopperton Street.
- ii. It is hoped to have a village Christmas meal at the Masons Arms (similar to last year) in early December.
